NOTICE

The Mediation Cell attached to the Delhi State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission proposes to prepare a panel of Mediators for mediation in the Consumer Cases. Applications are invited from the eligible Indian Nationals in terms of Section 75 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019, the Consumer Protection (Mediation) Rules, 2020 and the Consumer Protection (Mediation) Regulations, 2020, who, satisfies the following criteria:

- (i) retired Judges of Supreme Court of India;
- (ii) retired Judges of the High Courts;
- (iii) retired Members of a Consumer Commission;
- (iv) retired District and Session Judges, retired Additional District and Session Judges or other retired Members of the Higher Judicial Services of a State;
- (v) retired Judicial officers, having experience of not less than ten years;
- (vi) an advocate with a minimum experience of ten years at Bar;
- (vii) the mediators empanelled with the Mediation Cell of the Supreme Court of India, High Court or a District Court;
- (viii) a person having experience of at least five years in mediation or conciliation;
- (ix) experts or other professionals with at least fifteen years' experience or retired senior bureaucrats or retired executives.

2. The terms and conditions of the Mediators, including the fee payable to the Mediators, shall be, as referred, in the relevant provisions of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019, the Consumer Protection (Mediation) Rules, 2020 and the Consumer Protection (Mediation) Regulations, 2020.

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3. The eligible persons, desirous for empanelment as Mediators, shall dispatch their applications in such manner that their applications, complete in all respect, should reach the office of the Registrar, Delhi State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, First Floor, A-Block, Vikas Bhawan, new Delhi – 110002 latest by 06.10.2022, upto 5.00 P.M . Applications received thereafter for reasons whatsoever, shall be rejected.

4. The Selection Committee can adopt any criteria for scrutiny and shortlisting of applications and for determining its procedure for making its recommendations, after taking into account the suitability, integrity as well as relevant experience of the candidates.

5. The eligible persons, desirous for empanelment as Mediators, may submit their applications in the format provided at Annexure-I.
