#### DETAILS OF IMPORTANT/ LANDMARK CASES

##### 1. **Union of India Vs. Bhagmal** (RSA 202,203,204/ 2008)

Three separate appeals were filed by government departments (NDMC, DDA & Union of India) assailing the judgement of Ld. Civil Judge. These were decided on 30.5.2008 by the single judgement setting aside the order of Ld. Civil Judge by passing judgement running into 427 pages. This litigation had started in 1968.

This judgement was challenged in the Higher Courts and has been upheld at all instances

##### 2. **State Vs. Abu Salem** (SC No. 113/08)

An application under section 321 CrPC was dismissed on 28.08.2009. Charges for various offences under IPC and MCOCA were framed and thereafter prosecution evidence was recorded.

##### 3. **State Vs. Jallaluddin etc.** (SC No. 107/08)

In this matter communication is in Urdu and in code language. There were eleven Pakistani & Kashmiri terrorists involved in this case including Aftab Ahmed Ansari, kingpin of Indian Mujahiddin. This matter was heard on day to day basis. Voluminous record was to be perused which was in eighteen different volumes, which includes more than 4000 pages of charge sheet, lengthy depositions including more than 300 pages of deposition of the IO and statement of accused had more than 300 – 500 questions of each accused. This judgment runs into 692 pages along with 35 pages of Annexure, 38 tables and 9 flow charts.

The judgement had been upheld by the High Court of Delhi.

##### 4. **State vs Basanta etc.** (SC No. 09/09 etc)

In the year 2012 thirteen cases of 2009 hooch tragedy of Police Stations Rajouri Garden and Khyala had been disposed off. These voluminous matters having eight different accused persons in each case and about forty witnesses.
