ORDER

It has been noticed that Advocates/Litigants have been demanding/insisting for issuance of First Free Copy of the judgment without filing an appropriate application to that effect, which is necessary for the purpose of limitation in filing the appeals/revisions and is in contravention of the Consumer Protection Regulations, 2020.

Regulation 21(1) of the Consumer Protection Regulation, 2020 reads that a certified copy of an order shall clearly specify the date when free copy was issued, date of the application, date when the copy was made ready and the date when it was delivered to the Advocates/litigants

Accordingly, it is directed that the First Free Copy of an order shall be issued to the Advocates/Litigants only after an application is filed by the concerned in the Registry. The Registry is further directed to clearly specify in the certified copy of an order, the date of application, the date when the copy was made ready and the date when it was so delivered to the Advocates/Litigants.
